

CALL FOR ENTRY 29th annual open members' show

summary

Open to all current Members of The Contemporary Dayton (The Co)—one submission per person—every submission included, the Open Members' Show is regarded as one of the highlights of the year, with up to 100 artists, novice to experienced, participating. Artwork reflecting your interpretation of the theme, *What I Did During COVID19*, encouraged, but not required.

Work must be produced in the last three years and not been shown recently at a local venue. Work must be no larger than 40 inches WIDE, including any frame or display unit. There is no height restriction. For larger work, please contact us to make special accommodations.

eligibility

There is no entry fee. Traditionally, entrants must have a current Membership, but during the unprecedented hardships during this time of COVID-19, we are waiving membership as a criteria for participation. We do appreciate if you are able to renew your Membership at this time, and Membership 90-day deferments are available if you contact us. Membership starts at \$25 for students and \$50 for individuals. Membership information can be found at thecontemporarydayton.org.

conditions

One work per entrant; work in all media will be eligible. Two-dimensional work must be fully framed and wired, and ready to hang from picture hooks. The exhibition committee reserves the right to decline any work that is considered unsafe or inadequately presented. The Co reserves the right to photograph work for publicity purposes.

sales

We encourage artworks to be available for sale, but this is not mandatory. The Co is available to assist with pricing artworks to reflect Fair Market Value (FMV) and may contact artists to discuss pricing. The exhibition traditionally has a very high sales rate as we market to beginning and experienced collectors the value of work by local artists. The Co's commission rate is 40%.

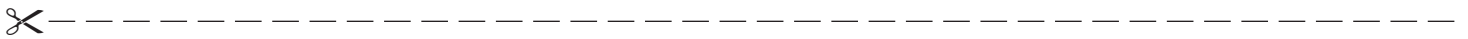
